Stewardship

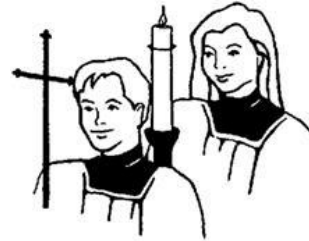


"The stone the builders rejected has become the corner stone..." - MATTHEW 21:42

The Pastor's Workshop



The Miracle of the Sun - 'Do not be afraid, I will do you no harm'. These and many other messages are attributed to Our Blessed Mother speaking to the three children at Fatima in Portugal one hundred years ago. One of the greatest signs witnessed by thousands at Fatima was the 'dancing' of the Sun. This is not an article of faith. As such Catholics are free to believe or not.....I wish to believe. While endorsed by the church, it is not demanded. We have recently been captivated by the solar eclipse. We know the path of the sun and the moon down to the millisecond. However God can get our attention in any way God wishes. I think everyone has an episode in their life that is transcendent. It happened in Nazareth when the angel spoke to Mary. It happened as well, I believe when Mary spoke to us at Fatima. On **October 13, 1917** God captured the hearts of people with the Sun dancing. Can this be explained scientifically.....probably not. But most things of faith don't depend on logical explanation.
