St. Mother Teresa
Of Calcutta**

The Humble Religious Sister

Born on August 26, 1910 of Albanian descent and baptized as Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu, Teresa recognized her calling early and left home at age 18 to join the Irish Sisters of Loreto in Dublin. She was soon sent to India and professed her first vows on May 24, 1931, choosing the name Teresa after St. Therese of Lisieux. From 1929 until 1948, she taught young women, first a school in Darjeeling and then at St. Mary’s High School in Calcutta, where she eventually became principal and was known as Mother Teresa.

The Missionary of Charity

One unique feature of Teresa’s new order, Missionaries of Charity, was that in addition to the traditional vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, a fourth vow “to give wholehearted and free service to the poorest of the poor” would be added. *to be continued next week*
