## **Deacon's Corner**

Do you take the Eucharist for granted? In this busy world we often seem to be going throughout our days punching a time clock or checking off our to-do list. Is that how you approach the Eucharist at Mass? Is it just part of the Sunday ritual so you can get on with your days list?

In the first reading Elijah is worn out from fleeing from his persecutors and takes rest in the shade of a tree. He is awoken by the angel who gives him water and cake.
