Dynamic Catholic, Alive! – Forms of Prayer

It is important for us to include the 4 main forms of prayer into our conversations with God. There is an acronym that can help with this: ACTS - 1) *Adoration* (acknowledgement that we are creatures of the Creator), 2) *Contrition* (interior repentance), 3) *Thanksgiving* (gratitude for blessings), and 4) *Supplication* (petition). The Eucharist contains and expresses all the forms of prayer. Do you cultivate these forms of prayer in your prayer life? Have you ever attended a life-changing retreat, such as ACTS or Christ Renews His Parish?
