## **Deacon's Corner**

So, holy days of obligation, these are like suggestions correct? Wrong, they are not suggestions, these are **MUST** attend days, according to the Catholic faith, unless there are specific reasons such as health or work, and even then, work would require a schedule that would not make attending one of the times for Mass possible; sports is not a valid excuse.

A quick refresher course: holy days of obligation are days of the year when Catholics **MUST** attend Mass in addition to the normal Sunday Mass. The United States has six: January 1st "The Feast of Mary, the Mother of God," 40 days after Easter Sunday "Ascension Thursday" (Individual dioceses determine if moved to Sunday of the week), August 15th "Assumption of Mary into Heaven," November 1st "All Saints Day," December 8th "The Feast of the Immaculate Conception," and December 25th "Christmas."

It should be noted that this is in addition to weekly Sunday Mass. Not Mass on Christmas and Easter, but every Sunday to fulfill your "obligation". There was a sign that I thought was one to remember outside a church last weekend it read, "We are open Every Sunday, besides Christmas and Easter." Remember we are the model of our faith for the next generation.
