***From the Pastor's Pen***

On Tuesday, January 12<sup>th</sup>, Sebastion Lury from Beyond Sunday came down to talk to the Beyond Sunday committee about how to coordinate the Beyond Sunday donations for the Roman Catholic Foundation of Eastern Missouri. The goal for St. Joseph Parish is \$305,000 and the goal for St. Anne Parish is \$65,000.

Sixty percent of our goal which is \$183,000 would go to the Roman Catholic Foundation of Eastern Missouri and the other 40% of our goal which is \$122,000 would go towards repairing the church and the parish plant. Such things that need to be repaired are the tuck pointing of the exterior of the church, painting of the church interior, new flooring, and repair of the tapestry in the sanctuary. We also need to repair the hall floor downstairs in addition to repairing the sidewalks and a renovation of the parking lot at the school grounds.

Sixty percent of St. Anne's goal which is \$39,000 would go to the Roman Catholic Foundation of Eastern Missouri and \$26,000 would go for church repairs at St. Anne's Parish. We are trying to save towards these renovations. Beyond Sunday would certainly help us to address some of these issues which we have. These dollar amounts for both parishes will only be realized if we meet our goals. If we get beyond our goals, we will still have the same proportion in order to apply for church repairs. Please receive the people who will be calling on you to make a pledge in the next few weeks. Sebastion Lury will be coming down to help us in this effort and to explain the program.

2016 is the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the completion of St. Joseph Church in 1916. Our present church was blessed by the Archbishop in October of 1916. If at all possible, could we celebrate once again in late October on the 100 anniversary of the completion of our church building.

**Special Collection**

This weekend's special collection is part of a national campaign to help recent victims of disasters across the country, including the flood here in the St Louis area. Our parish will work closely with Catholic Charities of St. Louis and other community partners to help people recover, which we know may take many months.
