**Deacon’s Corner**

Disciple comes from the word discipline. So to be a disciple is to have discipline when it comes to learning and knowing our faith.

In today’s Gospel Jesus talks about the sheep in need of a shepherd. Often we dismiss this as not referring to each of us but to our pastor, our bishop or the Pope. In fact they would be included, but He is calling all of us. For if we are truly Christians, followers of Christ, we are called to be shepherds in our own way to His sheep and to do so we are called to establish discipline in our lives, the discipline that comes from knowing our faith.

All of us young and old do not like homework; we want to be taught in the presence of the teacher but not have to work after we leave, whether at Mass or at a class on Wednesday night. Where our education system has gotten off track is we fail to continue to learn and apply our education, we see homework as punishment not rewarding; this is true especially in our faith.

To shepherd Jesus’s sheep we must continue in our daily lives to learn and apply our faith so that we do not lose it. We do so by reading our bible, not just hearing the word on Sunday or in class on Wednesday. In reading our Catechism and books on our Catholic faith by good Catholic writers in our homes, at work, where ever we might be. Yes, “homework” is required if we are to be true disciples and followers of Christ.
