**Latin America Apostolate**

On Sunday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, the collection will be taken for the support of the Latin America Apostolate of the Archdiocese of Saint Louis. This collection supports the presence of our 4 Saint Louis Priest Missionaries in Bolivia. Bolivia continues to suffer from a severe shortage of native Priests. In St. Louis we have roughly 1 Priest for each 2,000 Catholics. In Bolivia, the ratio is 1 Priest for each 20,000 Catholics. Our Priest Missionaries are helping to train native Priests in Bolivia. In addition, they proclaim the Gospel, celebrate the sacraments, and offer pastoral care to their parishioners. Due to great poverty in Bolivia, many people are living in conditions we can barely imagine – without access to clean water or sanitation or food.

Our Missionaries can only do what we make possible through our prayers and sacrifices. Please be generous in the collection for the Latin America Apostolate of the Archdiocese of Saint Louis on Sunday, August 2, 2015.

**Deacon's Corner**

It has been shown that it takes one generation from poor or inadequate adult catechesis (passing down the Gospel through written and spoken words with visual and audio aids) to non-church attendance and it then only takes an additional generation from non-attendance to unbelief. Have you seen this to be true? So, what is the Church doing about it?

This last weekend I had the pleasure to take part as a chaperone and deacon in one of the many Steubenville Youth Conferences. In this one place gathered were over 3,800 young Catholics. One young Catholic stated after the conference, "I didn't really believe in God, but now after going there, meeting and celebrating I believe that God is real."

What I saw last weekend was the Gospel come alive; in today's readings we hear of the multiplication of food. The first reading God helps Elisha multiply food for the people and a thousand years later we see Jesus do so for the hungry people. What can we learn from this, we can learn just how generous God is to each of us, providing to us not only the spiritual food we need but physical food as well.

The Steubenville Youth Conference began as a small event in Steubenville Ohio and now throughout the summer during July youth at locations around the country come to celebrate the Eucharist and the Catholic faith, the multiplication of food for the journey and the strengthening of Catholic faith is done right before your very eyes. Have faith and believe in the Gospel.
