**Following the Redeeming Christ
Through our Redemptoristine
Contemplative Life**

The Redemptoristines, as we are familiarly called, were founded in Italy in 1731 by Sr. Maria Celeste Crostarosa and St. Alphonsus Liguori as an Order of contemplative nuns. We follow the Redeeming Christ through our life of prayer and sacrifice.

Through our apostolate of prayer, we pray in the name of the Church for all the people of God. This apostolate is sustained and strengthened by Holy Mass, chanting the Divine Office, spiritual reading and private prayer.

We live a simple Community life, blending a spirit of joy and praise in the everyday response to the Holy Spirit.

Our Redemptorist Fathers and Brothers and their work for the most abandoned have a special place in our prayer.

The mysteries of Christ in His Incarnation, Passion and the Eucharist are particular devotions of our Order as is Mary under the title of Our Mother of Perpetual Help.

Our dark red habit, black veil and medal of the Risen Redeemer are signs both of Christ's redeeming love and our commitment to evangelical life in the Church.

In the past 250 years, monasteries have been founded throughout the world. One of these is in Canada and two are in the States. Our Liguori Community founded a monastery in the Philippines and in Thailand.
