“No one has greater love than this, to lay down one’s life for one’s friend.” What life has such value?

Jesus talks about laying down one’s life and we for the most part think of the physical life, for that is the example that he presented. But, he did more than just that, he gave us an example of the sacrifice of service.

We all have an image of our ideal life, the dream life and for each one of us it is different. How many dreamed of winning the lottery; maybe living the lifestyle of the rich and famous? Do you think that at some point Jesus and his Apostles did not dream the same dream? Jesus was even tempted by the Devil to have the world? Paul was on the fast track to being a leader of the Jews, to have power and riches. They all laid down that life and took up the life of the Cross so that others might truly live a life worth living, a life of value, a life of meaning.

To lay down a life that has no true value is not a sacrifice but a release. The life the world convinces you is yours is a false life, a life with no meaning. But the life that Jesus has offered us in following him through his own sacrifice has worth beyond this world, beyond this mortal life.

To live a life devoted to following the teachings of Jesus Christ, to follow the Church, to be fully “Alive in Christ” is to live a life worth laying down and that is what we are called to do; to serve the Lord in sacrifice to others and in laying it down we live.
