Deacon's Corner

How at peace are you right now? If you cannot say, "I am fully at peace" then you should ask yourself what is keeping me from not being so?

To truly love our Lord is to live our lives following the commandments in "deed and truth." In action and in thought, in all that we do, we should be striving to do so and when we go off course we should remember that our spiritual life and growth come directly from him. He is the vine, we are the branches and God is the vine grower. He works every day cutting back the access, working to keep the weeds out, to produce only the best fruit. Every day from the very time we were but a thought in our parents minds, He knew us, he knew the soil that we would grow in.

Jesus is the vine, we are the branches. When we attempt to pull away, to detach ourselves from him, we are weakened and the drink that is produced from the harvest of fruit becomes bitter and if picked from the vine and thrown to the ground is spoiled. By living our lives in deed and truth we remain attached to the vine, picked only by the vine grower when the time is right to produce the sweetest of wines.

When the world comes along and pulls us away from the vine, we must remember the soil that we were planted in, the soil of our Baptism, the nourishment received in the Eucharist, and the light shining down on us through our Confirmation will reconnect us to the vine and will produce sweet wine again. The Vine Grower knows his vineyard.
