**From the Pastor's Pen
Our Lady of Fatima**

"Following the example of St. John Paul II, a great devotee of Our Lady of Fatima, let us listen attentively to the Mother of God and ask for peace for the world." - Pope Francis

Celebrating the 100th anniversary of apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima, Pope Francis will lead the evening recitation of rosary and celebrate Mass on the anniversary at the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima when he visits Portugal on May 12-13.

The Pope will make the two-day pilgrimage to the site where Mary appeared to three shepherd children on May 13, 1917. On Sunday, May 13, 1917, the three children were in the fields with their sheep when they saw a flash of lightning and the image of a "lady all dressed in white. She was more brilliant than the sun and radiated a light more clear and intense than a crystal glass filled with sparkling water when rays of the burning sun shine through it." Our Lady told the children to pray the Rosary every day to achieve peace in the world and promised to visit again the next month. The apparitions continued once a month until October 13, 1917, and later were declared worthy of belief by the Catholic Church.

Living Fatima in the Family:

- Pray the Rosary.
- Make the First Saturday Devotion.
- Emulate the Blessed Children of Fatima by offering up illness, inconvenience, and distress for the sake of peace in the world.
- Go to confession.
- Place a statue of Our Lady of Fatima in a prominent place in your home.
- Pray the Fatima Sacrifice Prayer at bedtime: "Oh my Jesus, I offer this for love of Thee, for the conversion of sinners, and in reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary."
