Why Our Archbishop's "Beyond Sunday" Campaign Is So Important

We really need your support starting in January, 2016. In 2011, Archbishop Robert J. Carlson introduced "Alive in Christ!" a strategic plan to engage the hearts and minds of young Catholics. The Roman Catholic Foundation of Eastern Missouri was established to fulfill a key promise of Alive in Christ!—to enhance financial resources for schools and tuition assistance for Catholic families. Beyond Sunday is the Foundation's first major initiative. This Archdiocesan-wide fundraising campaign will greatly impact our parishes and school communities for generations. The parish goal for St. Joseph is \$305,000 and the parish goal for St. Anne is \$65,000. This Campaign is a 60/40 campaign, meaning that \$183,000 (St. Joseph) and \$39,000 (St. Anne) will go towards tuition scholarships and school grants throughout the Archdiocese for the Beyond Sunday campaign and \$122,000 (St. Joseph) and \$26,000 (St. Anne) is designated to be used for our parish needs.

Deacon's Corner

Peace be with you!

Our reflection: does our sacrifice meet our personal requirement of giving or does it meet the level that God calls us to?

The first reading we hear of the widow, who was convinced that she after eating what little she had, her and her child would die. Elijah opened her eyes to the power of God. For in living out her faith and giving what she had to Elijah to eat, she ate for the rest of her life, never going hungry.

Jesus reminds us, "Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life." (Jn 6:27)

The Gospel tells the story of those who gave of their surplus while the widow gave all that she had. Like the first widow, she lived out her faith, trusting in God. She showed to the wealthy of the world that true wealth is not found in money, but in God and our faith. For in putting in all that she had, placing her trust in God to provide for her needs, she put in more than the richest of them all.

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." I often think that maybe it should read like this, "Blessed are the poor; in spirit theirs is the kingdom of heaven." See the difference; for in our struggles when we do not have a surplus to give, when we give from that which provides for our needs not our wants, there we walk with Christ, for on the Cross he had no more to give. There we see the sacrifice of our faith.
