**Deacon's Corner**

“What do you want me to do for you?” In today’s Gospel Jesus asks Bartimaeus this question, but he also asks us the same question. So what do you want Jesus to do for you?

Many may be quick to look financially, but we must reflect on the life of the one Jesus first asks along the side of the road. You see, Bartimaeus is not asking of his wants, but of his needs. Our reflection today is; do I ask Jesus as it relates to my needs or to my wants? Has my desires blinded me to what Jesus has, is and will work in my life?

Focus on the Gospel see beyond the physical suffering of Bartimaeus, see the spiritual; look to that place where we let go of the material and see the richness in the gift that God provides through the Holy Spirit in the form of grace. There if we allow ourselves to go, there we will find our prayers are answered. Not in our time, not by an earthly clock can we measure this for God does not operate at that level.

If we are patient, we will see that all of our prayers to our needs and those we pray for are answered. Not by our understanding or plan but by Gods. Shakespeare wrote that “all things be ready if the mind be so.” For those of faith we should remember; all things are answered if the faith be so.
