What Makes a Mission
a Vincentian Parish Mission

- It centers on the Eucharist. The main service is usually the celebration of the liturgy with an extended homily being the mission talk.
- Major emphasis is on conversion and reconciliation. One day will be devoted to this.
- There is no fee for a Vincentian parish mission. A free will offering by way of a second collection after communion is taken up at the conclusion of the mission. There is no charge for expenses.
- A specific prayer which is promoted is the prayer of St. John Gabriel Perboyre, C.M. Prayer requests and intentions are taken and brought back to Independence, MO where they are placed in the chapel and prayed for every day at Mass for at least a year.
- Mission preachers attempt to model the five virtues of St. Vincent De Paul... humility, simplicity, meekness, mortification and zeal.

Please plan to attend our Vincentian Parish Mission which will be held next year March 18, 2017 through March 23, 2017.
