## **Deacon’s Corner**

The capital sins, do you know them? Maybe you might know them better as the “deadly sins”, there are seven: pride, envy, lust, anger, gluttony, greed and sloth.

As we pray this week in looking closely at our personal stewardship for our parish and the Church, let us take time and quiet ourselves, let us look deep and see where we are going astray and allowing sin to creep ever so slowly into our everyday lives so that we do not wake to find ourselves drowning in the sins of death; death of the soul.

You see stewardship, serving, giving not of what we have left over, but giving first before we take what we need brings us closer to Jesus; closer to our Father. Giving not so much of our finances but of the gifts God has given us so that we can live out his desires for others through our lives. You see if we place God’s desires first by putting the needs of others before our own, we coat ourselves with grace that the deadly sins cannot creep into our lives. But we must be ever on guard, ever mindful.

“Envy represents a form of sadness and therefore a refusal of charity; the baptized person should struggle against it by exercising good will. Envy often comes from pride; the baptized person should train himself to live in humility: Would you like to see God glorified by you? Then rejoice in your brother’s progress and you will immediately give glory to God. Because his servant could conquer envy by rejoicing in the merits of others, God will be praised.” CCC2540
