The best pictures, I believe are people shots.....the church is not a building, but the people of God. We can also include great religious art.....possibly pictures on our campus.



This weekend is **World Mission Sunday**. It's easy to forget that the church is a universal church, not only American, but African, European, Latin etc. So often we

get caught up in the concerns of our local Catholic community, and we overlook the call of Jesus, "Go out to all the world." In our American Catholic history, there is the tremendous legacy of congregations going to the far ends of the earth with the message of the Gospel. I can think of no better organization than Maryknoll. The photo is of Fr. Thomas Walsh arriving in China in 1918. Maryknoll men and women left this country for the Far East and Latin America, with little more than a satchel. Many suffered greatly, some were martyred. On this World Mission Sunday we take to heart their witness, and the great challenge to take the Gospel message to the ends of the earth.
